Overall, revenues are trending at 57.35% of the adopted budget and expenditures are trending at 12.62% of the adopted budget.

The property tax due date is September 30th. Thus far, 15% of the property tax revenue has been collected. This percentage is consistent with collections the previous 2 fiscal years at this same period.
